New South Wales Touch Association is pleased to announce that 233 teams and over 300 referees will be decending on Port Macquarie for the 2018 NSW Touch Football State Cup.

The draft draw has now been released and can be viewed via the "NSW Touch" Smart Device App which is available for FREE from the Apple App Store and Google Play for Android devices.

In a continuation of past years, there are certain competitions which have three tiers in where Friday is the preliminary day, Saturday the graded day and Sunday the finals day. In many of these competitions this includes a Championship Series, a Bowl Series, a Plate Series and Shield Series. Alternatively, to this there are also competitions which have a regular round robin competition followed by the finals series.
