NSW Touch Football is pleased to release the 2024/25 representative season Affiliate rankings. The rankings process is a detailed account on the performance of each Affiliate across NSWTA events for the 2023/24 season. These include Vawdon Cup, Country Championships and State Cup.

The final rankings are determined by the **two strongest** results of the three major events that NSWTA conduct. Given that a number of Premier League teams chose to play one event an adjustment was made to provide parity and allowing for two results. The explanation is below.

Affiliate teams in each event are allocated a points value based on their finishing result. In calculating the best two results each event is also weighted according to strength, prestige, and team numbers. State Cup, as the State Championship is the highest valued and weighted event.

Rankings are used to determine the allowable Player Points for an Affiliate. The Rankings are also used, in conjunction with a team's current performances when determining either divisions or seedings for an event.

For transparency, please see the method that is used when determining the Affiliate rankings.

**NB**. Where a Premier League or State Cup Championship team only participated at State Cup, the following was applied for parity.

- A Sydney Based team that finished in the top four at State Cup received 1<sup>st</sup> place equivalent points for Vawdon Cup.
- A Sydney Based team that finished in 5<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> at State Cup received 3<sup>rd</sup> place equivalent points for Vawdon Cup.
- A Sydney Based team that finished outside the top eight of State Cup received 4<sup>th</sup> place equivalent points for Vawdon Cup.
- A Country Based team that finished in the top four at State Cup received 1<sup>st</sup> place equivalent points for Country Championships.





- A Country Based team that finished in 5<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> at State Cup received 3<sup>rd</sup> place equivalent points for Country Championships.
- A Country Based team that finished outside the top eight of State Cup received 4<sup>th</sup> place equivalent points for Country Championships.

The following table is provided so Affiliates, Affiliate Coordinators and Affiliate coaches are aware of the 2024/25 representative season allowable Player Points System limits as a result of the above rankings.

Affiliates ranked outside the top 10 are allowed the same points cap as teams 9<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup>. If an Affiliate has moved into the top four (4) and the player list remains intact from the previous representative season they will be able to maintain all players that participated during that year.

Affiliates ranked outside the top six in the state and have three or more teams in a division are eligible to spend the allocated points however cannot play more than 180 points in Premier League and/or Open A.

**NB**: A player having previously transferred to an Affiliate will be able to remain with that Affiliate, regardless if the number of teams at that Affiliate drop and they are therefore over the allowed TOTAL point's threshold. Should this be the case and the Affiliate is over their points limit, they



will not be entitled to further imports until such times as they are below the required limit for their Affiliate.

Any clarification required by the Affiliate Coordinator must be sent in writing to the NSWTA.
